1006. To consider grant application to Little Mill Village Hall

Application circulated to Cllrs prior to meeting. LMVHA has accepted a quotation of £6,870 for the exterior of the hall to be painted. LCC will provide a grant of £5,000 to the hall upon completion of work and presentation of the invoice from the contractor.

1007. Correspondence to MCC re; Cae Melin Road

Due to adoption issues Cae Melin Road is not being sufficiently maintained by The Local Authority. Additionally, LCC has stopped hearing updates from MCC or its flood officers about the ongoing flood issues in Little Mill. County Cllr Howells agreed to pursue these issues with MCC.

1008. Correspondence to MCC re; overhanging trees on Glascoed Lane

LCC has been contacted by residents and business owners on Glascoed Lane reporting issues with overhanging hedges and overgrown verges causing hazards and visibility issues with domestic and commercial traffic. A tree canopy is causing considerable issue for taller vehicles. County Cllr Howells is currently exploring traffic calming measures for the lane so will take these actions forward. Cllr Carpenter & County Cllr Howells to liaise and carry out a drive-through of the lane to note key areas to report to MCC Highways.

1009. Revised electrical work quotation £250 for Tel-box

Council to pay National Grid £259.26 to raise an MPAN number and connect the telephone box for a new supply. To agree PJ Electrical revised quotation for the electrical work (£250) required to install a light and spur socket for the defibrillator cabinet. The electrical contractor is charging for materials only and happy to donate their time for this community project.
